The Budget Committee for the City of Adair Village will hold its first meeting on Tuesday, April 17th, 2018 at 6:30 PM at the Adair Village City Hall, 6030 William R. Carr Avenue, Adair Village. The purpose of this meeting is to present the budget and the budget message and to hold a public hearing.

SUMMER DAY CAMPS

COMMUNITY SERVICE OFFICER

It is time once again to get out the lawnmowers. Starting on April 1st you must keep all grass and weeds under ten inches in length.

40.420 (1) No owner or person, in charge of any residentially-zoned property, shall permit upon such property, improved or unimproved, or upon any parkway or side walk area abutting such property, any excessive growth of weeds, grass or other vegetation. Such excessive growth shall be deemed noxious vegetation, and it shall be the duty of every owner or person in charge of such property to cut down or otherwise destroy any noxious growth on such property or parkway or sidewalk area abutting thereon as often as necessary, to prevent such growth from being unsightly or a fire hazard, or maturing and going to seed.
