LEAF COLLECTION and STREET SWEEPING

The leaf pick up days are scheduled for **Monday, October 29^h, Monday, November 12th and Monday, December 10th.** Please rake leaves into the street just before the collection dates. Be sure that you are not blocking bike lanes, storm drains or driveways.



Street sweeping will happen the day after leaf pick up—October 30st, November 13th and December 11th.

Please move vehicles off the streets on both leaf pick up and street sweeping days. Parking is available at City Hall.

We will be testing the hydrants in the village during the month of October. This is a requirement of the Insurance Service Office (ISO) to insure that there is adequate water available to suppress a fire if the need should arise. ISO is the rating consultants that provides efficiency rating for fire departments nationwide. Our rating is a 3/3Y out of 10; 1 is the best ,Corvallis is a 2. Maintaining that rating is important to you because it drives your insurance premiums. So, I apologize for the dirty water that is stirred up during the test.
