WHAT'S NEW WITH THE NEW WATER BILLING SYSTEM?

By now you are holding your first new water bill and have noticed that it is completely different. You may have also noticed that your account number has changed! Please make a note of it. For those of you who send payments through your bank, please update your account number with your bank so that we can accurately post your payment to your account.

We expect to roll out the Express Bill Pay option by the end of January or early February. When it is ready, we will post a notice on our website and on NextDoor. (Hopefully you will all help spread the word to your neighbors, too.) Once it is available, you will be able to set up automatic payments without a convenience fee! We encourage everyone who can to take advantage of this option.

In the long run, we are confident that the new system will serve us all much better. Again, we greatly appreciate your patience and understanding. No one has been charged a late fee in November or December. Cheers and Happy New Year!
