RESOLUTION NO. 2021 --1

WHEREAS, the Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC) program under the Disaster Recovery Reform Act of 2018 (DRRA) will support states, local communities, tribes and territories as they undertake hazard mitigation projects, reducing the risks they face from disasters and natural hazards; and

WHEREAS, the BRIC is a new FEMA pre-disaster hazard mitigation program that replaces the existing Pre-Disaster Mitigation (PDM) program; and

WHEREAS, the BRIC program guiding principles are supporting communities through capability- and capacity-building; encouraging and enabling innovation; promoting partnerships; enabling large projects; maintaining flexibility; and providing consistency; and

WHEREAS, There is \$500 million dollars available in BRIC funding to states, local communities, tribes and territories and the application period to apply for fiscal year 2020 BRIC funding was opened on September 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the City of Adair Village has applied for financial assistance for available funding from the BRIC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Adair Village City Council hereby authorizes City Administrator, Pat Hare to execute for and on behalf of the City of Adair Village all required forms and documents for the purpose of obtaining financial assistance for the Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC) program under the Disaster Recovery Reform Act of 2018 (DRRA).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage by the City Council and approval by the Mayor.
