The final Leaf pick-up day has been scheduled for Monday, December 6. Please rake leaves into the street the day before. Rows should be long and narrow and two feet away from the curb. Be sure that you are not blocking bike lanes, storm drains or driveways. Street sweeping will take place the day after leaf collection; Tuesday, December 7. Please move vehicles off the streets on street sweeping days. Parking is available at City Hall. Please do not rake any leaves into the street after December 6th.

STORMWATER EDUCATION

Did you know that your pet can impact water quality in the Willamette River? Pet waste contains bacteria and nutrients that can be harmful to fish and other aquatic life. If your pet goes to the bathroom, be sure to pick up their waste and dispose of it in a trash can. City parks have stations with waste bags to make it easy for you to pick up your pet's waste when you are out for a stroll!.
