#### **UGB EXPANSION UPDATE**

The Adair Village City Council will hold a public hearing at 6:00 p.m. on December 6, 2022 at Santiam Christian School, 7226 NE Arnold Ave. The Adair Village City Council will be considering an amendment to the existing comprehensive plan and comprehensive plan map for the purpose of expanding Adair Village's Urban Growth Boundary. There are two subject properties involved in the expansion which encompass roughly 55 acres. The subject properties as shown on the UGB expansion map available on the City website.

The Adair Village and Benton County Planning Commissioners have made a recommendation to approve the expansion to the City Council and County Commissioners. All UGB expansion and comprehensive plan documents are available at www.adairvillage.org.
