BUDGET COMMITTEE MEETING

The Budget Committee for the City of Adair Village will hold its second meeting on Tuesday, May 6th, 2025, at 6:00 PM at City Hall, 6030 William R. Carr Ave. The purpose of this meeting is to present the budget and the budget message and to take comments and questions from the public. The public will also have a chance to speak on behalf of State Revenue Sharing.

A copy of the budget may be inspected or viewed after April 4th on the website of the City of Adair Village, which can be found at www.adairvillage.org \Your Government\Finances\Budgets. This budget was prepared on a basis of accounting that is consistent with the basis of accounting used during the preceding year. This budget is for the annual period of July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

ADAIR HISTORY DAY

GRASS AND WEEDS

It is time to get out your lawnmowers. Beginning April 1st, you must keep all grass and weeds under ten inches in length. We also suggest that you consider applying a non-toxic weed and feed product to your lawns to help minimize the growth of dandelions which tend to grow faster than grass.



SPRING AND SUMMER WATER REMINDER

As we head into the warmer months, the City of Adair Village would like to remind everyone to check their sprinkler systems when turning timers back on for the season. This is the perfect time to catch any leaks, and we've already seen a few issues around town.

Please help us conserve water by making sure your system is running properly and try to water your lawns in the early mornings or late evenings to reduce water loss from evaporation.

In addition to the road repairs, we will also be painting curbs and replacing some of the older street signs throughout the community to help keep Adair Village safe and looking great.
