WATER CONSERVATION: WHEN TO WATER YOUR LAWN

A healthy, green lawn depends a lot on *when* and *how* you water it—
not just how much.

Best Time to Water

- **Early morning** is best, **before 10 a.m.** The sun isn't too hot yet, so water soaks into the soil instead of evaporating. Grass blades dry by night, which helps prevent diseases like mold or fungus.
- **Late afternoon (around 4–6 p.m.)** is okay too, if mornings aren't possible. Just avoid watering **too late**, or the wet grass may attract disease overnight.

Worst Times to Water

- **Midday (10 a.m. – 4 p.m.)** — too hot, water evaporates fast.
- **Night** — grass stays wet too long, increasing chance of fungus and disease.

How Often to Water

- Most lawns need **1 to 1.5 inches of water per week** (from rain or sprinklers).
- Water **deeply, not often** — once or twice a week is usually enough. This helps roots grow deep and makes grass stronger during dry weather.

Other Things to Consider

- **Type of grass:** Some grasses need more water than others.
- **Climate:** Hot, dry places may need more watering.
- **Soil type:**
 - ◇ Sandy soil dries quickly → needs water more often.
 - ◇ Clay soil holds water longer → needs less frequent watering.

Easy Test to Know If Your Lawn Needs Water

- **Step on it:** If the grass springs back, it's fine. If it stays flat, it's time to water.

Final Tips

- Use a sprinkler that spreads water **evenly**.
- Don't water if it recently rained or the soil feels soggy.

Combine good watering habits with mowing and fertilizing to keep your lawn healthy.
