2025 LEAF COLLECTION AND STREET SWEEPING SCHEDULE


The **2025 leaf pick up days** are scheduled for the following Mondays: **October 27, November 10, November 24, December 8, and December 22.** Please rake leaves into the street just before the collection dates. Be sure that you are not blocking bike lanes, storm drains, or driveways.

Street sweeping will happen after leaf pick up on the following Tuesdays: **November 12, and January 6.** Please move vehicles off the streets on both leaf collection and street sweeping days. Parking is available at City Hall.
