Maintenance Activity: Staff reported no leaks in March. Staff worked with contractors to complete the water service line replacement on Cori Cout. Staff replaced three broken meter box lids.

WASTEWATER TREATMENT REPORT

Flows into the WWTP have leveled off with drier weather. Staff cleaned the chlorine contact chamber and wasted from the Imhoff.

Maintenance Activity: Storm drains are clear. Staff check and clean all drains daily.

STREETS MAINTENANCE REPORT

Maintenance Activity: Streets are in decent shape.

Maintenance Activity: Staff were able to mow for a few days in March. Staff removed large limbs from city hall and the park. Staff also were able to do some mowing at the water plant and the wastewater plant.

Maintenance Activity: We are still running the plant 20-24 hours per week. Staff worked with contractors on annual maintenance of our chlorine generation machine.


WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT



I am writing to initiate a formal request to the U.S. Postal Service for the assignment of a unique Zip Code for the City of Adair Village, Oregon. We firmly believe that Adair Village should have been granted its own Zip Code when it was incorporated in 1976, and we now consider it an urgent necessity. The following information and background strongly support the need for Adair Village to have its own Zip Code.

To provide some historical context, Adair Village was established and incorporated in 1976, built upon the site of Camp Adair, a former military installation that served various branches of the United States Military from 1942 to 1969. During those years, there were three separate post offices located within the present boundaries of Adair Village. From 1942 to 1946, a post office served Camp Adair, which functioned as a training site for several divisions during World War II and later as a prisoner of war camp. Then, from 1947 to 1951, the site was leased to Oregon State University for student housing, hosting another post office. Finally, from 1961 to 1969, the Adair Air Force Station and a SAGE radar station, which still exists as a private business within our city, had their own post office.

Following the decommissioning of the Air Force Station, the land was divided between the City of Adair Village, Benton County, and the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife, forming the EE Wilson Game Management Area. In 1976, the City of Adair Village was officially incorporated, with a population of 586 according to the 1980 Census. The population remained relatively stable until 2000 when it was primarily seen as a "bedroom" community for Corvallis. However, in 2001, Adair Village expanded its Urban Growth Boundary (UGB) to incorporate new acreage, resulting in a significant population increase. Today, our population stands at 930 residents, with another UGB expansion recently completed, nearly doubling our city's area, and projections estimate a population of 2,800 to 3,000 within the next 20 years.

Despite our growth, Adair Village remains the only incorporated city of its size, and even smaller, in the entire state of Oregon without its own Zip Code. Many smaller cities and unincorporated areas in our region have their own post offices and unique Zip Codes. To put this

into perspective, please consider the following examples from neighboring communities:

- Corvallis-Adair Village (930 population) Adair Village is 8.4 miles from the Corvallis Post Office.
- Albany-Tangent (985 population) Tangent is 7.2 miles from the Albany Post Office.
- Dallas-Falls City (965 population) Falls City is 9.9 miles from the Dallas Post Office.
- Detroit (265 pop.)-Idanha (230 pop.) These two towns, with smaller populations than Adair Village, are 4.5 miles apart and both have their own post offices.
- Drain (1080 pop.)-Yoncalla (1115 pop.) These neighboring towns, each with over 1,000 residents, are 5.1 miles apart and both have their own post offices.

These examples demonstrate that Adair Village's situation is not unique, and many similar communities in our region enjoy the benefits of having their own Zip Codes. Additionally, the absence of a unique Zip Code for Adair Village has created various challenges and issues, particularly concerning mail and package delivery. Real estate listings for Adair Village continue to be listed as Corvallis addresses, hindering our community's identity and potential for economic development. At a recent meeting with local realtors, it became evident that many were unaware of Adair Village's status as a separate, incorporated city due to the shared Zip Code with Corvallis. One citizen who just moved to Adair Village called and said "I've called Corvallis several times and they will not provide water service out here."

Furthermore, the potential for misdirected emergency service response is a growing concern due to the confusion surrounding our shared Zip Code. Emergency response vehicles have been delayed in reaching Adair Village residents due to the location confusion between Adair Village and south Corvallis. Such delays in critical situations are unacceptable, and we believe that having our own Zip Code is not only essential for our community's identity but also for the safety and well-being of our residents.

Adair Village has evolved significantly over the years and is poised for continued growth, with plans for a new downtown retail area and other developments. We believe that having our own Zip Code is essential to firmly establish our community's identity and address ongoing issues with emergency response delays. Moreover, as our population is expected to triple within the next decade, it is essential to begin planning for an Adair Village Post Office. In accordance with the review process initiated by Congress in 1991, we kindly request that you review this information and forward it to your District manager for a decision regarding our request.

Thank you for your prompt attention to this matter, and we look forward to your favorable response.

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Region 10 has approved and obligated funding for Adair Village Lift Station 1 & 2 Emergency Power project submitted under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program for Disaster DR-4562-OR.

The City of Adair Village wastewater collection system relies on three lift stations to convey a majority of the city's wastewater to the wastewater treatment plant. This project will install a 15 kW diesel generator at Lift Station No. 1 and a 20 kW diesel generator at Lift Station No. 2. This project will mitigate against natural hazards that impact the operations of this critical facility and protect the community from the adverse health effects of disrupted services.



- The recipient agrees that all use of funds under this subaward will be in accordance with the
 Hazard Mitigation Assistance Unified Guidance in effect at the time of the Disaster Declaration,
 relevant HMGP guidance and policy memos and directives, as well as the HMGP in Code of
 Federal Regulations (CFR) Title 44 Part 206.
- The recipient may receive payment in advance using the United States (U.S.) Department of Health and Human Services Payment Management System formerly known as SmartLink. The recipient may advance portions of the approved Federal share to the Subrecipient provided the recipients maintain procedures to minimize the time elapsing between the transfer of funds from the U.S. Treasury and their disbursement to the Subrecipient. Subrecipients must comply with the same payment requirement as the recipient and must comply with the requirements specified in the recipient's subaward agreement.
- The recipient shall follow regulations found in 2 CFR Part 200, Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards and the FEMA/State/Tribe Agreement in effect for the subject Disaster Declaration.

The recipient must submit a report for every quarter of the period of performance, including partial calendar quarters, as well as for periods where no grant activity occurs. Future awards and fund drawdowns withholdings may occur if these reports are delinquent.
- The recipient shall submit Quarterly Performance Reports in Excel format to the Regional Hazard Mitigation Assistant Specialist within 30 days of the end of each quarter. The Recipient shall submit Quarterly Performance Reports thereafter until the grant ends. Reports are due on January 30, April 30, July 30, and October 30. Quarterly Performance Reports shall report the name, completion status, quarterly expenditures, and payment-to-date of each approved activity/subaward award under the Grant Award.

- Unless otherwise approved by Region 10, the recipient must submit a closeout package with all
 financial, performance, and other reports and required documentation within 180 days after
 Subrecipient's notice of completion of the project, or expiration or termination of the

 payment of the final reimbursement to the Subrecipients.
- For closeout of this project, the Governor's Authorized Representative or Tribal Authorized Representative shall send a letter of request to the Region 10 Mitigation Division Director, to close the project programmatically and financially. The letter will include the following:
 - the date work on the project was fully completed, or for planning subawards, the date and copy of FEMA approval of the new or updated plan,
 - 2. the date and a copy of the recipient's final site inspection for the project,
 - the final total project cost and Federal share, any cost underrun, or overrun, including a Final Cost Line Item budget, to enable any closeout deobligation or obligation of additional funds in National Emergency Management Information System,
 - certification that reported costs were incurred in the performance of eligible work, and that the approved work was completed, or if not, an explanation as to the final status of the project and why the project was not completed,
 - confirmation that the mitigation measure is in compliance with the provisions of the FEMA/State/Tribe Agreement and this approval letter,
 - 6. a memo from the Subrecipient addressing how each required environmental and special programmatic condition was met (including attachment of any required documentation),
 - 7. submittal of all required documentation relative to the specific project type, for example. acquisition/demolition, or elevation, including all necessary data to close the project in the Property Site Inventory in FEMA's Hazard Mitigation Assistance grant systems.
