Its hard to believe that 2019 is here. The City would like to thank everyone for their continued support as we continue to adapt and grow. This year we will see some major changes in our community with the development to the south. The City is expecting at least twenty new homes in 2019. The development is in its first phase which will be 58 new homes. The developers are hoping to begin work on the second phase in 2019 which will be an additional 56 homes. The total development consist of four phases totaling 198 homes. This much needed housing is going to provide our businesses with support, will spread the cost of aging infrastructure needs, and most importantly will help Adair Village to develop a downtown that will create a greater sense of community.

A MESSAGE FROM THE COMMUNITY SERVICE OFFICER

Adair Village

Land Use Development Code Section 6.401

Any person who keeps chickens in the City of Adair Village shall apply for and obtain an Annual Backyard Chicken Permit prior to acquiring the chickens. For those residents with a current permit, it is time to renew. The application forms can be picked up at City Hall. Inspections will be conducted by the City between January 22nd – 31st. Residents must have a valid backyard chicken permit prior to making an appointment for inspection.



Reminder: City Ordinance 40.480 Storing Property on Public Ways. No person shall use any portion of the traveled roadway, sidewalk, or other portion of the public way or road right-of-way to store or keep recreational sports equipment or personal property of any kind, except vehicles and trailers, as defined in Chapter 43 Parking and Standing Vehicles, which limits trailers and RV's to four days on any public way.

Adair Village is looking for persons interested in becoming a Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) member to help staff our local team.
