BUDGET NOTICE

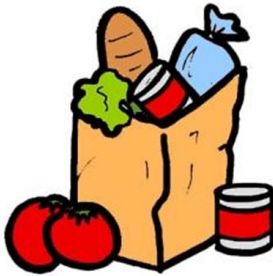
The Budget Committee for the City of Adair Village will hold its second meeting on Tuesday, May 5th, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. by teleconference. The call-in number is (978) 990-5000, and the access code is 423177. The purpose of this meeting is to approve the budget and to take comments and questions from the public. The public will also have a chance to speak on behalf of the State Revenue Sharing.

This budget was prepared on the same basis of accounting as used during the preceding year. This budget is for the annual period of July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021.
