DO YOUR WEEDS NEED TO BE CUT?

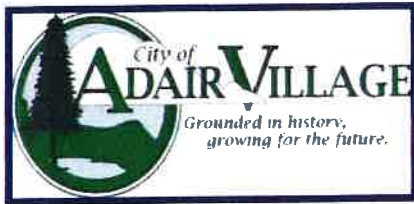

STORMWATER EDUCATION

The summer heat is making a dip in the pool seem nice and refreshing. For those of you who have backyard swimming pools, did you know that your pool can impact water quality in the Willamette River? It can, but only if you let it. Here are some tips so you can minimize the impact your pool has on the river:

- If you must drain your pool, check the chlorine level in your pool and wait until you cannot detect chlorine before starting to drain.
- Avoid draining your pool into the storm drain system.
- Store your pool chemicals somewhere that will minimize the chance for leaks or spills. If possible, store them in a covered area.
