## CHICKEN COOP PERMITS

Adair Village Land Use Development Code Section 6.401: Any person who keeps chickens in the City of Adair Village shall apply for and obtain an annual backyard chicken permit prior to acquiring the chickens. For those residents with a current permit, it is time to renew for 2022. **Please remember that ducks and other types of fowl are not permitted inside Adair Village.**

## STORMWATER EDUCATION

Springtime is here and that might have some folks starting yard maintenance projects. Did you know that how you landscape and maintain your yard can impact the quality of our nearby wetlands and rivers? Here are some helpful tips to limit the impact of your household landscaping practices on the environment:

- Try to limit the use of pesticides and fertilizers. If you need to use them, make sure to avoid rainy days when the chemical will just get washed off your lawn and into the streams.
- If you are doing some new landscaping, consider using native plants and grasses that are drought- and pest- resistant.
- Cover piles of dirt, bark, or mulch. These materials can blow away and into nearby waterbodies.
