UGB EXPANSION UPDATE

The Adair Village and Benton County Planning Commissions will be meeting again on October 11th at 6 p.m. at Santiam Christian School to respond to all written comments and other questions raised by the Commissions and public. After those items are addressed, the Planning Commissioners will go into deliberations and make a recommendation to the City Council and County Commission. Further public hearings will take place in November with the City and County. Those notices will be forthcoming after a recommendation is made.

Residents wishing to attend the public meeting should park at Village Christian Church and enter Santiam Christian School at the East entrance. The meeting will be held in the MAPS Room.

LEAF COLLECTION AND STREET SWEEPING

The leaf pick up days are scheduled for **Monday, October 24^h**, **Monday, November 7th**, **Monday, November 21st** and **Monday, December 5th**. Please rake leaves into the street just before the collection dates. Be sure that you are not blocking bike lanes, storm drains, or driveways.

Street sweeping will happen the day after leaf pick up—**October 25st**, **November 8th** and **December 6th**.

Please move vehicles off the streets on both leaf pick up and street sweeping days. Parking is available at City Hall.
