GRASS AND WEEDS

It is time to get out your lawnmowers. Beginning April Ist, you must keep all grass and weeds under ten inches in length. We also suggest that you consider applying a non-toxic weed and feed product to your lawns to help minimize the growth of dandelions which tend to grow faster than grass.



STORMWATER EDUCATION

Springtime is here and that might have some folks starting yard maintenance projects. Did you know that how you landscape and maintain your yard can impact the quality of our nearby wetlands and rivers? Here are some helpful tips to limit the impact of your household landscaping practices on the environment:

- Try to limit the use of pesticides and fertilizers. If you need to use them, make sure to avoid rainy days when the chemical will just get washed off your lawn and into the streams.
- If you are doing some new landscaping, consider using native plants and grasses that are drought- and pest- resistant.
- ♦ Cover piles of dirt, bark, or mulch. These materials can blow away and into nearby waterbodies.
- Try to sweep up yard waste rather than hosing it into the street. This waste can flow into the storm drains and pollute the river.
