THE GREATEST GOOD

Doing the greatest good for the greatest number of people is the Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) motto, and it speaks to the utilitarian nature of the organization. It is both learning how to be prepared to help yourself and your family, but also your neighbors in the event of a disaster or emergency challenge.

The primary reason for CERT training is to give people decision-making, organizational, and practical skills to offer immediate assistance to family members and neighbors while waiting for professional help to arrive. The goal of the CERT program is to train volunteers to be effective and efficient in disaster mitigation, response, and recovery without placing themselves in unnecessary danger.

Adair has had an active CERT program since 2018 and our small but committed team members meet monthly to continue training exercises. **But we need to grow so that we can be the most effective for the most people in our community.** We are looking for more Adair (or nearby) residents who:

- ◇ Are committed to doing good
- ◇ Are willing to complete the online basic training course
- ◇ Are willing to attend as many of the monthly trainings as possible

ADAIR VILLAGE BUDGET NOTICE

The Budget Committee for the City of Adair Village will hold its second meeting on Tuesday, May 2, 2023 at 6:00 PM at City Hall, 6030 NE William R Carr Ave. The purpose of this meeting is to present the budget and the budget message and to take comments and questions from the public. The public will also have a chance to speak on behalf of State Revenue Sharing.

This budget was prepared with the same basis of accounting as was used during the preceding year. This budget is for the annual period of July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024.

ADAIR FIRE HAS NEW PORTABLE RADIOS THANKS TO THE CONFEDERATED TRIBES OF SILETZ INDIANS

Last November Adair Rural Fire and Rescue was awarded a \$10,000 matching grant to replace our extremely outdated and broken-down portable radios. We immediately placed our order and our new radios have finally arrived and are in service! Communication between firefighters is critical on all calls. In certain situations, reliable, properly functioning radios can literally be a life saver.

The Siletz Tribal Charitable Contribution fund awards charitable organizations and local governments with grants for a variety of purposes. Adair Rural Fire and Rescue has been fortunate enough to receive five distinct public safety grants over the lifetime of the program. A grant for AED's, remote front mount bumper nozzles for two of our brush trucks, two separate grants for firefighter turnouts and this year's portable radios.
