RED CROSS ADULT FIRST AID/CPR/AED COURSES

The City has a trained Red Cross First Aid/CPR/AED instructor available to teach the course to Adair Village residents. We are gauging interest in taking this valuable course and want to know if there are enough people who want to learn the life saving skills and get certified or recertified. The course is taught as a blended course—most of it is online through the Red Cross Learning Center and then once participants complete the online portion, they are eligible to finish the course with an approximately 2 hour learning and testing session. The class size can be from 4 to 8 participants. If there is enough interest, we will schedule a class. STORM WATER EDUCATION

As the rainy season starts, remember that the stormwater runoff eventually ends up in our rivers. Let us try our best to protect the health of the rivers by preventing pollution from ending up in our stormwater runoff. Here are some easy ways you can do that in your own home:

- Use fertilizers sparingly and sweep up driveways, sidewalks, and gutters so that leaves and litter do not enter the storm drain.
- Check your car for leaks and recycle your motor oil.
- Never dump anything down the storm drain or into a stream.
- Pick up after your pet. Pet waste contains bacteria and nutrients that can harm the health of our nearby rivers.
