Please rake leaves into the street just before the collection dates. Be sure that you are not blocking bike lanes, storm drains, or driveways.

Street sweeping will happen the day after leaf pick up on the following Tuesdays:

Oct. 24
Nov. 21
Dec. 5



Please move vehicles off the streets on both leaf pick up and street sweeping days. Parking is available at City Hall.
