BUDGET MESSAGE

The Budget Committee for the City of Adair Village will hold its first meeting on Tuesday, April 14th, 2025, at 6:00 PM at City Hall, 6030 William R. Carr Ave. The purpose of this meeting is to present the budget and the budget message and to take comments and questions from the public. The public will also have a chance to speak on behalf of State Revenue Sharing.

A copy of the budget may be inspected or viewed after April 3rd on the website of the City of Adair Village, which can be found at www.adairvillage.org and then choose City Council/Budget/Finances. This budget was prepared on the same basis of accounting used during the preceding year. This budget is for the annual period of July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2027.

PLANNING COMMISSIONER NEEDED

The Adair Village Planning Commission is looking for a new member. The planning commission meets every other month on the third Thursday at 6:00 p.m. They review applications for planning actions, everything from property line adjustments to variances to annexations. They also provide input to the Council on long range planning issues such as transportation, storm water, infrastructure development, and downtown development. PROTECT OUR STORM DRAINS

Springtime is here and some folks may be starting yard maintenance projects. Did you know that how you landscape and maintain your yard can impact the quality of our nearby wetlands and rivers? Here are some helpful tips to limit the impact of your household landscaping practices on the environment:

- Try to limit the use of pesticides and fertilizers. If you need to use them, make sure to avoid rainy days when the chemical will just get washed off your lawn and into the streams.
- If you are doing new landscaping, consider using native plants and grasses that are drought and pest-resistant.
- Cover piles of dirt, bark, or mulch. These materials can blow away and into nearby waterbodies.
- Try to sweep up yard waste rather than hosing it into the street. This waste can flow into the storm drains and pollute the river.

The city would like to remind you of our TextMyGov service to receive important notifications. These notifications can include water safety or service outage notices, event updates, or other emergency alerts.

For Adair Village events updates: text **AVEVENTS** to **91896**

For Adair Village water updates: text **AVWATER** to **91896**

For Adair Village emergency notifications: text **AVEMERGENCY** to **91896**

After sending the initial keyword, you will be asked to reply “**YES**” to confirm opt-in. Repeat this process to opt in to the other two notification groups as desired. You may choose to opt out at any point by texting **STOP**. Stay informed, stay ahead.
