BUDGET MESSAGE

The Budget Committee for the City of Adair Village will hold its second meeting on Tuesday, May 5, 2026 at 6:00 PM at City Hall, 6030 William R. Carr Ave. The purpose of this meeting is to present the budget and the budget message and to take comments and questions from the public. The public will also have a chance to speak on behalf of State Revenue Sharing.

This budget was prepared on the same basis of accounting used during the preceding year. This budget is for the annual period of July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2027.

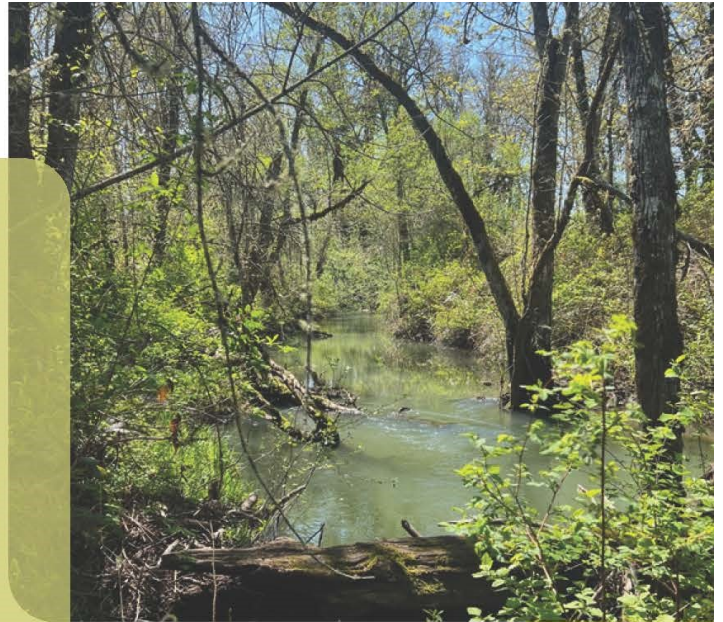
VEHICLE STORAGE

Did you know that the Adair Village Municipal Code prohibits storing a vehicle on the roadway? Vehicles that are not frequently moved or have expired registration can be found in violation and may be towed. Vehicles stored in the roadway often have moss and other vegetation growing beneath them; this vegetation shortens the lifespan of the road surface and increases the cost to community members due to repairs.
