All that wastewater flows to the City's wastewater treatment plant where it is treated and disinfected before being pumped to the Willamette River. While our City's wastewater treatment plant is designed to treat sewage, it is not designed to treat the water for medicine, pesticides, oils, paints, and other liquids that can sometimes get poured down the drain. Please remember to properly dispose of these hazardous wastes so they do not end up out in the Willamette River that we all love to enjoy in during the warm weather!
