ORDINANCE NO. 2014 - 05

WHEREAS, this matter having come before the City Council of the City of Adair Village on June 3, 2014, upon the recommendation of the City Administrator that the City amend its current Animal Control ordinance in order to better protect public peace and welfare; and,

WHEREAS, approving this amendment will bring the Animal Control ordinance into concord with the City's Nuisance and Land Use ordinances concerning Agricultural Uses in R-2 zones; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interests of the City and its residents to implement amended language to the present Animal Control ordinance for this purpose; now, therefore,

THE CITY OF ADAIR VILLAGE CITY COUNCIL ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Animal Control Ordinance, Section 41.530 Livestock and Poultry shall be amended to read (Language added is underlined and language removed is ~~struck through~~).

No animals, livestock of any kind, or poultry shall be raised or kept on any property within the city limits of Adair Village, except as permitted by Adair Village Land Use Development Code (AVLUDC) Section 6.401. Dogs, cats or other traditionally domesticated animals may be kept, provided that they are not kept, bred or maintained for any commercial purposes. Harboring these animals on ones property even if the animals are not being used for commercial use will result in a citation in accordance to section 41.990 of this ordinance.

Section 2. Emergency Clause. The provisions of this ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Adair Village and it is in the best interests and welfare of the residents of the City of Adair Village to implement the new Code at once. Therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage by the City Council and approval by the Mayor on the Effective Date.

Section 3. Effective Date. Passed by the City Council and approved by the Mayor of the City of Adair Village this 3rd day of June, 2014.
